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QUARTERLY STATEMENT OF PRODUCTION, DEVELOPMENT AND EXPLORATION

SEPTEMBER 2007

PREMIER

PRODUCTION

Overburden removal was 33.6 per cent lower than for the previous quarter, as production was interrupted by weather conditions.

Coal production for the quarter was 763,000 tonnes, 29.3 per cent higher than for the previous quarter. The previous quarter was affected by Verve taking less product in order to reduce its coal stockpiles.

DEVELOPMENT

Commissioning of the Research and Development Char Plant continued during the quarter.

EXPLORATION

There was no significant exploration activity during the quarter.

CURRAGH

PRODUCTION

Overburden removal was 14.0 per cent lower than for the previous quarter, mainly due to a planned 10 week major dragline shutdown.

Coal production for the quarter was 2,280,000 tonnes (comprising 1,558,000 tonnes of metallurgical coal and 722,000 tonnes of steaming coal), 7.2 per cent higher than for the previous quarter. Metallurgical coal production decreased by 2.1 per cent and steaming coal production increased by 38.0 per cent compared to the September 2006 quarter. Coal production was constrained by the coal handling and preparation plant availability in July and a planned six day shutdown in August.

Expectations for full year production of export metallurgical coal at Curragh remain in the range of 6.5 to 6.9 million tonnes, subject to satisfactory mine, rail and port performance.

DEVELOPMENT

Curragh has commenced a feasibility study into expanding the mine to achieve annual export tonnages of between 8.0 and 8.5 million tonnes of metallurgical coal.

EXPLORATION

There was no significant exploration activity during the quarter.

BENGALLA

PRODUCTION

Wesfarmers' share of coal production for the quarter was 558,000 tonnes, 30.4 per cent higher than for the previous quarter, due to a catch up of lost production, which had resulted from severe flooding across the Hunter Valley during the previous quarter.

DEVELOPMENT

A Development Consent Modification Application is being prepared for the extension of mining operations south into the Wantana pit area. Feasibility studies to determine the viability of increasing ROM production from 8.7 million tonnes to 10.7 million tonnes per annum are continuing.

EXPLORATION

There was no significant exploration activity during the quarter.
