# QUARTERLY STATEMENT OF PRODUCTION, DEVELOPMENT AND EXPLORATION

#### 1 JANUARY TO 31 MARCH 2013

### **CURRAGH**

#### **Production**

Overburden removal was 23.8 per cent lower than the previous quarter due to a targeted reduction of overburden removal capacity, combined with wet weather impacts throughout the quarter.

Coal production for the quarter was 2,267,000 tonnes (comprising 1,535,000 tonnes of metallurgical coal and 732,000 tonnes of steaming coal), 15.2 per cent lower than the previous quarter. Coal production was impacted by wet weather associated with Cyclone Oswald, which significantly interrupted rail and port activity for four weeks and led to mine stockpiles reaching capacity. Metallurgical coal production decreased by 15.4 per cent and steaming coal production decreased by 14.8 per cent compared to the previous quarter.

For the 12 months to 31 March 2013, metallurgical coal production increased 26.5 per cent to 7,747,000 tonnes, reflecting the additional capacity of Curragh's new coal handling and preparation plant.

### **Development**

There was no significant development activity during the quarter.

### **Exploration**

There was no significant exploration activity during the quarter.
